The Pre-K students worked so hard this year learning their letters, numbers, colors, shapes, and so many other things. We also made new friends throughout the year.

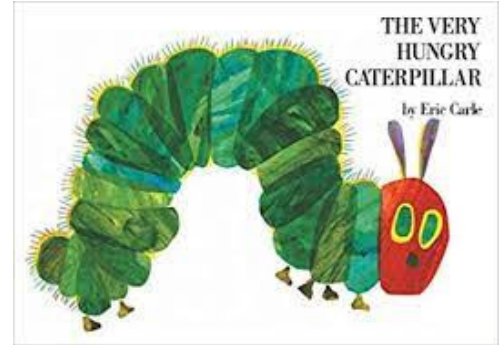
We want to thank the parents for all the help and support they provided during this different year of school, that we all endured. We hope everyone has a great summer! Be safe!

We are also practicing categorizing items by height, shape, and size. We have had such a great school year, and can't believe it's almost over!

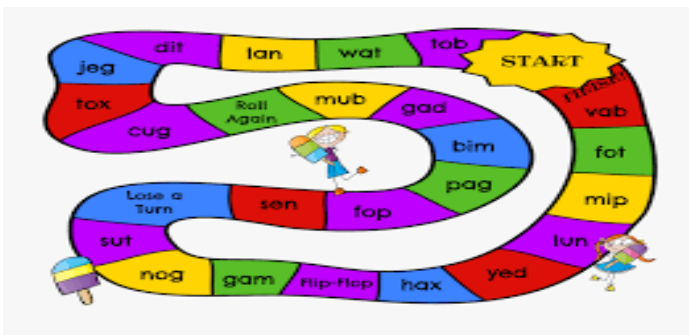
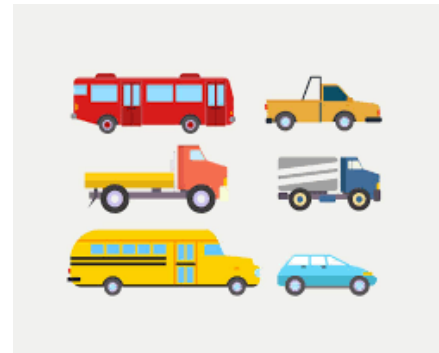

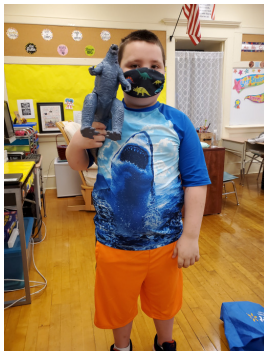
It is hard to believe that the end of the school year has arrived!



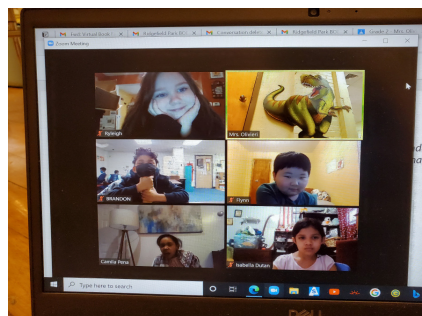
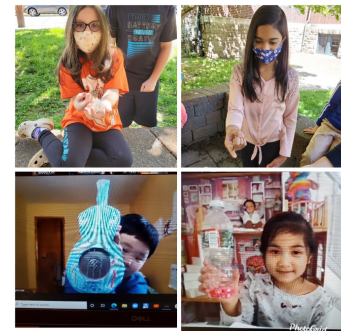

include building our habitat dioramas, making musical instruments, having car races while learning about force and motion, our butterfly release, the fossil cookie dig, and making space comets!

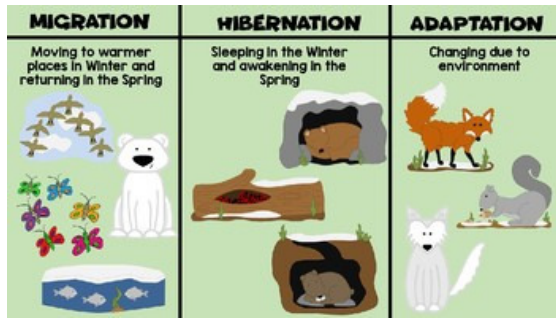

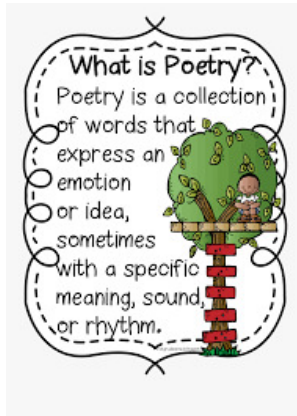
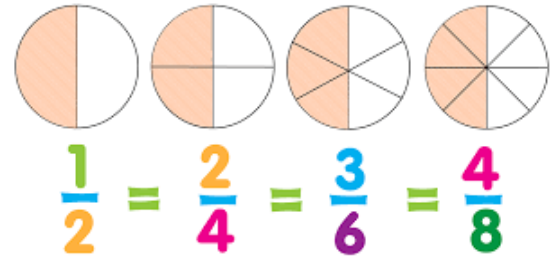
